

**Christos Constantine Bogiages, Jr.**

**Born: 30 March 1934 – 2 March 1969**

**(aged 34)**

*He was trained as an Air Force pilot at Craig Air Force Base in Selma, Alabama. Lieutenant Colonel Bogiages was a member of the 357<sup>th</sup> Tactical Fighter Squadron, Takhil Air Base, Thailand. On March 2, 1969, he was the pilot of a Thunderchief Fighter (F-105DS) on a mission over the Plain of Jars in Laos. His aircraft was shot down 5 miles southwest of Ban Na Mai, Xiangkhoang Province.*

*35 years later, his remains were found, identified, and repatriated. He was laid to rest at Arlington National Cemetery.*
