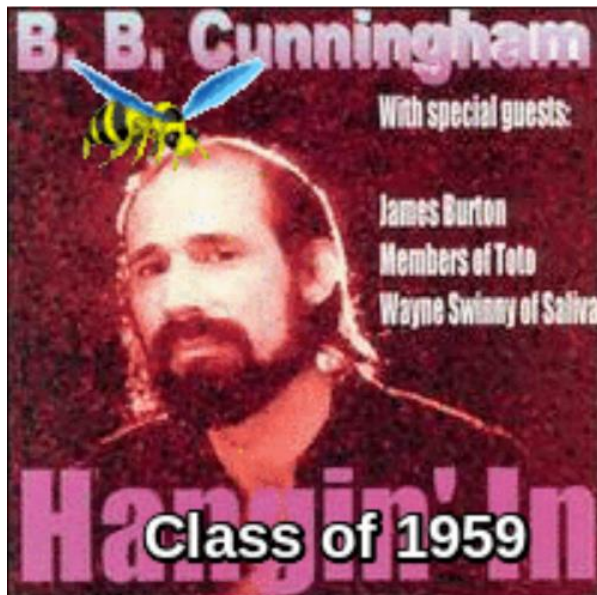


Class of 1959 – Blake Baker “B.B.” Cunningham, Jr.



Blake Baker Cunningham, Jr., the keyboardist and singer established a national reputation in 1965 as a member of the touring version of Ronnie and the Daytona's, known for the song "G.T.O." The band eventually became the Hombres, which scored a chart hit with "Let it All Hang Out": in

1967. B.B. had been the bass player for Jerry Lee Lewis since 1997. He was one of the great pioneers of rock music.
