Mrs. Hatchett published more than 3,000 poems and wrote five books of poetry, including "No Other Starr" and "Take Time to Laugh". She won many awards for her writing, locally and nationally, and was Poet Laureate emeritus of the Poet Society of Tennessee. She was also a member and officer of the American League of Penwomen Chickasaw Branch.

A watercolorist also, Mrs. Hatchett's portrait of writer Thomas Wolfe hangs in the Wilson Library at the University of North Carolina. With her late husband, University of Memphis professor William Hatchett, she compiled the Braden-Hatchett Thomas Wolfe Collection at the University of North Carolina Chapel Hill.

Mrs. Hatchett also wrote short stories, songs, and plays and won photography awards. She was also a poetry judge for the schools. She was a member of Highland Street Church of Christ and served on the board of Harding Academy.
