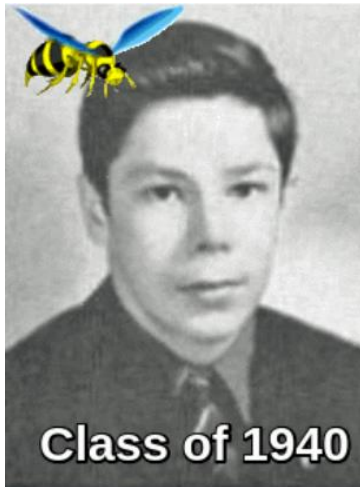


Class of 1940 – Jasper Edgar Richardson.



James attended Yale University where he received his B.S. in Physics, 1944. His Masters and PhD in Nuclear Physics were from Rice University, 1950. As an Atomic Energy Fellow at Oak Ridge, Tenn., he did physics research on the first Cobalt 60 cancer therapy machine in the United States for M.D. Anderson Hospital. He worked as a research physicist for Shell Research Center. He had five patents and many publications in his field. He is listed in Who's Who in the United States, Who's Who in the World, Who's Who in the South and Southwest, 2000 Outstanding Scientists of the 20th Century, and American Men and Women of Science.
