

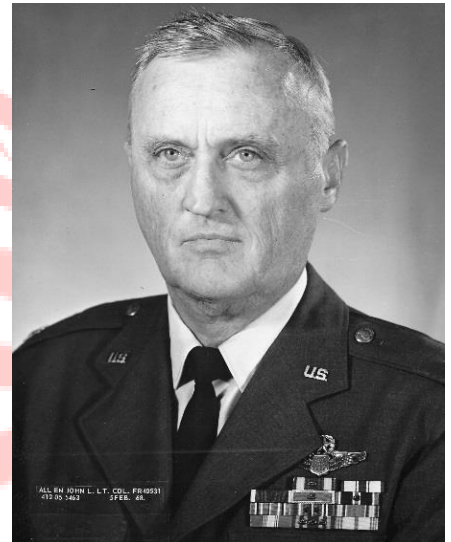
John Logan Allen, T-34

4 February 1917 – 2 July 1985

(aged 68)



Now known to be a German prisoner is Lieutenant John L. Allen, Memphis Flying Fortress navigator, whose brother, Major W. C. Allen, Jr., was waiting at an English air base to see him the day he failed to return from a bombing raid over Germany, May 13, 1944.



Official word of Lieutenant Allen's capture came to his wife, Erlyne Tidwell Allen thru information obtained by the International Red Cross. He is the son of Mrs. Nellie P. Allen.

A Tech High graduate and former Sears, Roebuck employee, Lieutenant Allen had been overseas since March 9 and completed 14 missions over Germany.
