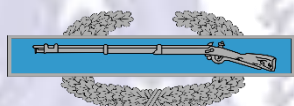


Fred Cook Beacham, Jr., T-36

27 February 1919 – 29 March 1945

(aged 26)



Previously reported missing on March 29, PFC Fred C. Beacham, Jr., husband of Gloria Haire Beacham, was killed in Germany on that date while fighting with the infantry of the Seventh Army. Overseas since last December, he had been awarded the Combat Infantryman Badge.

Private Beacham who was 26, attended Tech High School, and was employed by Memphis Street Railway Company before entering service last July. He received his basic army training at Camp Blanding FL. He leaves besides his wife, who lives at 2007 Nelson, two children, Patsy and Fred Louis Beacham; his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Fred C. Beacham, Sr. of 813 South Cooper, two brothers, Sergeant Charles Beacham, in the Philippines, and Bobby Beacham of Memphis, and two sisters, Miss Margaret Beacham and Mrs. Guy Tatum, both of Memphis.
