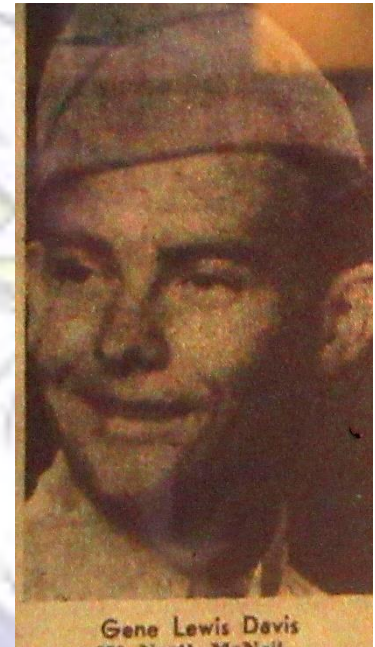


Gene Lewis Davis, T-44

18 September 1925 – 19 March 1945
(aged 19)



Private First Class Gene Lewis Davis, previously listed as missing in action in Germany 19 March 1945, was killed in action on that date, the soldier's parents, Mr. and Mrs. John M. Davis, has officially informed.

The 19-year-old fighter had been overseas since last November and in the Army since February of last year. He was a graduate of Tech High where he was a member of the Glee Club. He was an acolyte in the Church of the Good Shepherd. Before graduation he was a carrier for The Commercial Appeal.

Private First Class Davis, 19, Tech High graduate and glee member, who was listed as missing in action since March 19, was killed in action on that date, his parents Mr. and Mrs. J. M. Davis, have been notified. Davis was an outstanding musician at Tech High. He also was an active ROTC member for two years. As a member of the 63rd Infantry Division, Seventh Army, he went overseas last November. He joined the service a month after graduation last January. He also leaves a brother, Marshall W. Davis.
