The son of Mrs. Mabel C. Eaton, 3185 Powell, he was employed by the Western Weighing & Inspection Bureau before entering the Army in February.

Mr. Eaton was a U.S. Air Force Veteran of World War II, the Korean War, and Vietnam. He began his flying career at the age of 19 with the U.S. Air Force and retired as a lieutenant colonel after 30 years of service.
