

Lloyd Alton Follis, T-41

1922 – 27 April 1944

(aged 21-22)



A Tennessean has lost his life in action, while three other men from this area have been added to the list of men missing overseas. One of those three is Lloyd Follis.

Staff Sergeant Lloyd Alton Follis, 21-year-old son of Mr. and Mrs. Lloyd J. Follis of Garland, has been reported missing in the Central Pacific since April 27, 1944.

Sergeant Follis, flight engineer and waist gunner on a Liberator, was stationed in Hawaii and had been overseas since March 15. He had been graduated from Tech High and formerly was employed at Fisher Memphis Aircraft Divisions. He is the grandson of Mrs. T. A. Follis and G. L. Viar, both of Fowlkes TN, near Dyersburg.
