Motorcycle Crash Injuries Prove Fatal to John Forman

John Forman, young Memphis athlete and graduate of Tech High School, died early yesterday morning in an Aberdeen, Miss, hospital of injuries suffered June 10 in a motorcycle accident. He was 19.

Brother of R. D. (Red) Forman, Memphis aviator and swimming pool operator, young Forman was

en route to Columbus, Miss, to operate a portable skating rink in connection with his brother when the accident occurred.

Clay Powell, 21, of 116 North Bellevue, a companion, was injured slightly.

Suffering from internal injuries young Forman was given eight blood transfusions in efforts to save his life.

He as promoted to honorary major in the Tech High R.O.T.C. upon graduation in 1938. He was active in sports in high school and was a member of the State Teachers College football team last Fall. He was a member of Bellevue Baptist Church.

He leaves his parents, Mr. and Mrs. C. D. Forman of 2002 Linden; two other brothers, Bert and Charles Forman and a sister. Mrs. Genoa Wilson, all of Memphis.

Funeral services will be held this afternoon at 2 o'clock at National Funeral Home, conducted by Dr. Robert G. Lee. Burial will be in Memorial Park.
