On February 24, 1944, he was on the crew of the B-24H Liberator #42-7606 "Abie's Irish Rose" during a mission to Gotha in Germany. They were shot down by flak and crashed near Woluwe-St-Etienne, Belgium.

Six men bailed out and survived, captured, and held as POWs. Five men were killed in the air or the crash. Their remains were eventually recovered and laid to rest in a group burial at Zachary Taylor National Cemetery, Louisville, Jefferson County KY. This is a National American Cemetery administered through the Department of Veteran's Affairs.
