

Stanley Preston Green, T-43

28 August 1923 – 22 February 1950
(aged 26)



Paratrooper Private First-Class Stanley P. Green, 21, son of Mr. and Mrs. W. E. Green, 1114 Rayner, is a prisoner in Germany after missing in action in Belgium since January 4, 1945. His parents have been notified of his capture.

He is a Tech High graduate, went into the service in 1943 and overseas in September 1944.

Paratrooper Private First-Class Stanley P. Green has been reported missing in action with an airborne division in Belgium since January 4, according to a War Department telegram to his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Willie E. Green, 1141 Rayner.

He graduated from Tech in June 1943, entered the Army the next month and went overseas in September 1944.

He has two brothers, T/5 E. A. Green, with the Army Forces in Italy, and Ronald Green, Tech Student.
