

Jesse D. Gregg, T-35

19 April 1916 – 1 September 1944

(aged 28)



Private Jesse D. Gregg, who had previously been reported missing, was killed in action September 1 in France, the War Department has notified his wife, Mrs. Lola Hughes Gregg, 2744 Fillmore.

Private Gregg, 28, is the son of Mrs. Agnes Gregg, 848 Poplar. He was a graduate of Tech High School and had been employed at Chickasaw Ordnance Works before entering the infantry in February. Private Gregg has been overseas since the middle of August.

He formerly lived in Munford TN. He also leaves his sister, Mrs. W. R. Crumby, and three brothers, Sergeant Reuben S. Gregg, Walter Enoch, and William Franklin Gregg of Memphis.
