A 24-year-old Memphis Insurance agent drowned when he fell from a boat in Grenada MS yesterday afternoon. He yelled for help and Corps of Engineers rescue squadron reached the spot within 10 minutes, but his body hadn't been found when dragging was halted at dusk.

Identified as Stanley Gregory, he was vacationing with his wife at the home of Mr. and Mrs. Calvin Brown of Grenada. Mrs. Brown was his sister.

Mr. Gregory recently was discharged from the Air Force and had served in the South Pacific. He was an agent for the Life of Georgia Insurance Company. He and Mrs. Gregory, the former Miss Hester Hannah had been married less than a year.

He was a member of the Seventh Street Baptist Church.
