MEMPHIAN IS WOUNDED

Charles L. Hoard, son of Mr. and Mrs. Ruben T. Hoard of 621 Spring, was wounded in combat Sunday in Vietnam with only two months of duty left before returning to the United States.

A Defense Department telegram to his parents said Specialist Hoard was wounded in the left leg and the left side of his body from shell fragments in a booby trap. He is in a Vietnam hospital.

He had been stationed with the 25th Infantry Division since last August.

Specialist Hoard, 21, was graduated from Tech High School in 1966 and is planning to attend Bible college when he finishes his Army duty.
