

William D. "Billy" Jolly, T-39

5 October 1920 – 2 June 1944

(aged 23)



*Four soldiers from Tennessee have been killed or reported missing in action, according to War Department telegrams received by their relatives.*

*Mr. and Mrs. Walter W. Jolly of 3118 Chisca were notified yesterday that their son, Lieutenant William D. Jolly, was killed in England on June 2.*

*The 23-year-old member of the Army Air Forces entered the service March 10, 1943, and was commissioned last December at Spence Field, GA.*

*His wife, the former Miss Eloise Haire, lives at 3388 Carrington with her parents. Mr. and Mrs. A. H. Haire. He was graduated from Tech High in 1939 and was a foreman for Fisher Memphis Aircraft Division before his enlistment.*

*He also leaves two brothers, J. L. Jolly, who is a seaman, first class, in California with the Navy, and Myron K. Jolly of Memphis.*

*Lieutenant Jolly formerly was a carrier for The Commercial Appeal.*
