

Paul Brantley Lambert, T-43

8 March 1925 – 16 December 1944

(aged 19)



PFC Paul B. Lambert, nineteen-year-old son of Mr. and Mrs. O. D. Lambert, 727 Trigg, previously reported missing in action in Germany, December 16, 1944, had been reported killed in action on that date. He had been on combat duty since June. Frank Dearing said Paul's death, at the age of nineteen occurred "in action leading up to the Battle of the Bulge." Specific information on circumstances surrounding his death had not been found at the time of publication. According to the Report of Death document from the War Department dated February 23, 1945; "The individual named in this report of death by the War Department to have been in a missing in action status from 16 December 1944 until such absence was terminated on 17 February 1945, when evidence considered sufficient to establish the fact of death was received by the Secretary of War from a commander in the European Area."
