First Lieutenant Corin A. Lewis, flying a record shattering stream of supplies to the front, recently won two battle stars for participation in the campaign of Northern France and Germany.



The officer, son of Mr. and Mrs. William L. Lewis, 2016 Higbee Avenue, pilots a C-47 Air Transport Skytrain loaded with vital war cargo and medicine supplies, from bases in France to battle zone airstrips. Wounded combat men are his cargo on the trip back.

A graduate of Tech High, Lieutenant Lewis was a press operator for Chickasaw Ordnance Works, in Millington, before he entered the service in April 1942.
