Robert William McCain, 61, and Mary Juanita Berry Tittle McCain, 62, both of Lonoke, were killed when their van was blown off a freeway overpass.

They were driving their van west on Interstate 40 toward the Highway 31 junction when the tornado hit.

The vehicle was found 120 feet from the highway in a field, with the passengers trapped inside. Neither

person was wearing a seatbelt, and they died at the scene of the accident, authorities said.

Robert McCain was retired from the Air Force and from South Central Bell Telephone Company. He was a 32nd degree Mason, a Shriner, a member of the Order of the Eastern Star, the American Legion, the Confederate Air Force and the Lonoke Baptist Church.

Mary McCain was a retired beautician, a member of the Order of the Eastern Star and the Lonoke Baptist Church.
