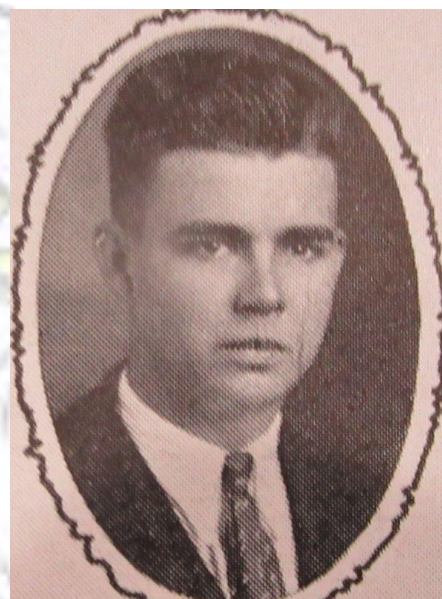


Harry Emil McFarling, T-30

3 May 1910 – 12 August 1944

(aged 34)



Private First Class Harry Emil McFarling, Fisher Aircraft employee before joining the Army in August 1943, was killed in action with the infantry in France, August 12, the War Department has informed his wife, Mrs. Margaret McFarling, 553 Edgewood. He was 33.

Private McFarling was widely known in Shelby County as a Tech High football star and gridman on Southwestern freshman team. He was sent to England in June.

He also leaves his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Harry McFarling, 815 E. Parkway S; two daughters, Alice and Betty Ann McFarling; two sons, Jerry and Glenn McFarling; and his brother, Glenn E. McFarling, with the Army Air Force in the South Pacific.
