RETURNS TO DUTY

Sergeant Arthur Roy McGoldrick, Jr. was badly burned July 29 when the B-24 on which he was radio gunner crashed and burned somewhere in the Asiatic area, but has returned to duty with his squadron, flying the "hump."

Son of Mrs. Frances W. McGoldrick, he is a Tech graduate and was working at the Navy base as an electrician when he entered the Army Air Forces in September 1942. He has been overseas five months.
