DIES AFTER FALL AT HOME

Hall Elmore Mosher of 434 East Dison, chief of budgeting and accounts for the U.S. Engineers, Memphis District, died at 10:30 Saturday night, April 9, after a fall in his home. He was 55.

Mr. Mosher's wife, Mrs. Alice Furr Mosher, said her husband was peeling potatoes at the kitchen sink about 4:30 p.m. When he blacked out and fell backwards striking his head on the cook stove. She said he regained consciousness a few minutes later and assured her he was all right. He went to bed about 8 p.m. and died 2 1/2 hours later.
