Police arrested a 27-year-old woman as

Donald R. Stills. The body of Stills was
found Sunday behind an apartment at
628 Breedlove.

Police yesterday released a woman
who was being held in the shooting death of Donald R. Stills.
The woman was arrested Tuesday after witnesses told police
she had been seen with Stills shortly before he disappeared

Donald R. Stills was shot to death in a wooded area behind
Breedlove Nov. 16. His family had reported him missing 10 days
earlier.

Donald R. Stills was last seen alive by his family the night of
November 6.

At about 4 p.m. On November 16, his body was found in a wooded area behind at 628 Breedlove, just south of Jackson Avenue near Interstate 240.

He had been shot to death.

His death is the Crime Stoppers crime of the week. A reward of \$1000 is offered for information that will solve the case.
