Corporal Hugh Talbert Lost Life After Jap Surrender

Corporal Talbert was killed in the Philippines August 31, his wife, Mrs. Evelyn Smith Talbert, 1139 Madison, was informed by the War Department today, Friday, September 21, 1945.

Corporal Talbert lost his life shortly after hostilities ended. "Details will be furnished later," the wire read.

Corporal Talbert went overseas early last month after serving more than two years in the States. He was a graduate of Tech High School. Before entering the Army, Corporal Talbert was in the radio buying department at Goldsmith's. He was a member of the Bellevue Baptist Church. He also leaves his mother, Mrs. John Lewis Talbert, and two sisters, Mrs. Landon Bates, and Mrs. M. L. Butts, all of Memphis
