*Sergeant Charles J. Thompson, 24, Tech High graduate, had returned to active duty after being wounded 13 January 1945 in Belgium, according to his wife, Mrs. Rebecca H. Thompson, 1588 Southern. He was wounded by shrapnel fragments.*

*Before entering the service in October 1942, he worked for Kelley & Jamison printing form. He went overseas last December.*

*Follow up: Served with the US Army during World War II and was awarded the Purple Heart for injuries received during the Battle of the Bulge.*
