

Edward Crump Treadway, T-38

21 July 1917 – 17 July 1944

(aged 26)



Private Edward Crump Treadway with a reconnaissance squadron of the 6th Cavalry, was killed July 17. He is the son of Mr. and Mrs. James M. Treadway, 1307 Azalia, and husband of Mrs. Bennye Butler Treadway. A graduate of Tech High, he was with Chickasaw Ordnance Works at Millington when he entered the Army in February 1941. He had been overseas since last October.

One sister, Sergeant Lois T. Caylor, is serving with the Marine Corps Women's Reserve at Quantico VA. He also leaves another, Mrs. Virginia Chronister, and two brothers, Charles and James M. Treadway, Jr., all of Memphis.
