PFC Arthur Nowlin Westbrook, Memphian, who helped make bombers at Fisher Aircraft before he entered the Army infantry early in February 1943, was wounded in action in Italy, May 13th, the War Department has notified his parents, Mr. and Mrs. A. O. Westbrook, 1323 Hollywood. A recent letter from PFC Westbrook said he was wounded in the hand and shoulder. He attended Hollywood School and is a graduate of Tech High School. Before going overseas last November, he trained at Camp Howze and Fort Sam Houston TX.
