

Horace Bedford White, T-40

6 March 1923 – 26 September 2000

(aged 77)



Second Lieutenant Horace B. White, reported missing in action over Germany on March 3, today was listed as a prisoner of war of the Germans. He was forced to bail out of the P-51 Mustang he was piloting.

Son of Mrs. H. B. White, 3611 Norriswood, he is a graduate of Tech High and of Curtiss-Wright Aeronautical school in Glendale CA.

He worked for Lockheed before entering the AAF in April 1942. He won his wings at Yuma AZ in May 1943 and went overseas a year ago this month.
