FISHING ACCIDENT

Memphis police searched until dusk last night for a fisherman who apparently fell out of his flat-bottom boat at North Lake yesterday afternoon.

He was identified as Jacob Williams, 32, of Applewood. Detectives said he and Mr. Taylor, 35, were fishing about 12:30 p.m. when they had trouble with a trolling motor. Taylor said he was

working on the motor when he felt the boat shake and turned to see Williams overboard. He said a cap over Williams's eyes prevented him from seeing the life preserver and cane pole that Taylor used to try to save him.

A rescue team began dragging the lake bottom about 2:30 p.m. said Lt. E. J. Winters of the South Precinct. The lake is located near the far west end of Shelby Drive, about four miles south of McKellar Lake.
