

William Edgar Wolf, T-42

23 September 1923 – 26 August 1944

(aged 20)



Private Wolf was admitted to hospital October 1943, diagnosed asthma bronchial disease, existed prior to service, and discharged back to duty in Feb 1944, readmitted to hospital July 1944 and died in hospital 26 August 1944.

William is buried at Manila American Cemetery, Manila, Philippines.

DIES IN NEW GUINEA

Private William E. Wolf, paratrooper in New Guinea, died there August 26, his wife, of 3568 Cowden, has been informed. Mrs. Wolf said her husband had been in the hospital but would not disclose whether he had been wounded.

Son of Mrs. Earl Bryant, Mountain Home AR, and Wyatt Wolf, Tuckerman AR, Private Wolf was a Tech High graduate and former Rotary Lift Company employee before entering service in February 1943. He went overseas last May.
